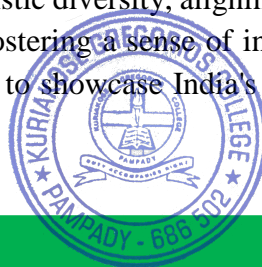


INDIAN KNOWLEDGE SYSTEM (IKS)





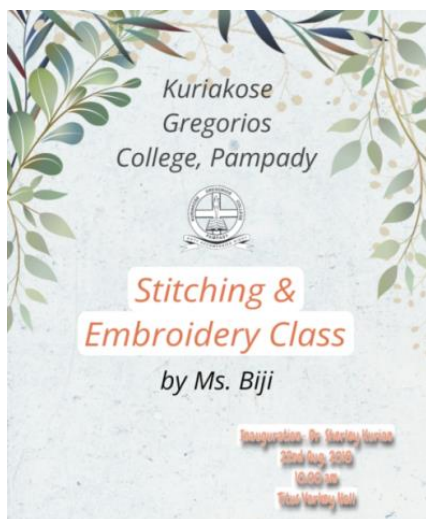




SKILL DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES
