

## ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2018-19

On the basis of the feedback received from various stake holders, the IQAC has taken the following measures.

1. Departments are directed to offer internships and field visits especially for Science Programmes.
2. Institutional Participation in NIRF & AISHE was ensured.
3. All departments are directed to offer a 30 hour add-on course for imparting additional skills for the students. Departments should constitute a Board of Studies and entrust the responsibility of running the course with the course coordinator of each department.
4. All mentors are directed to strengthen mentoring activities to facilitate the growth of mentees.
5. Orientation Programme was conducted for First year UG & PG students.
6. IQAC ensured active participation of all departments and NSS, NCC etc. in the Rebuilding Kerala venture by Government of Kerala for the reconstruction of Kerala economy devastated by the floods.
7. Career guidance sessions were conducted by Career and Placement Cell as well as various departments to enhance the employability of the students. Active alumni support was sought for this purpose.
8. IQAC in consultation with RUSA PMU & BoG prepared a Detailed Project Report taking into account the vision, mission and institutional development plan of the college. It aims at strengthening the academic and physical infrastructure of the college. The fund will help the institution to overcome its shortfall in infrastructure by constructing a new academic block, seminar halls, laboratories etc.

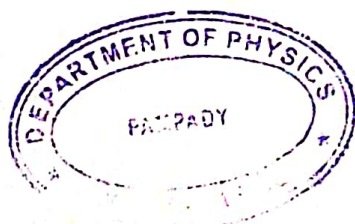

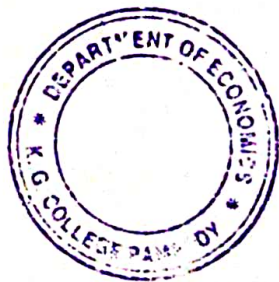

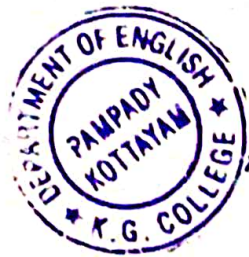

#	Feedback	Action Taken
