

## ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2020-21

On the basis of the feedback received from various stake holders, the IQAC has taken the following measures.

1. IQAC took measures to carry out online classes in the campus effectively. Teachers were given technical assistance for starting Google classrooms, conducting online tests, quizzes, Google meets, etc. Smart classrooms were made fully equipped to impart the best learning experience for students.
2. Feedbacks were collected from students regarding the challenges in accessing online classes. Financial accommodation was given to students to bridge the digital divide in rural and poor households. Institutional support, faculty and alumni support were extended to students for accessing virtual classes.

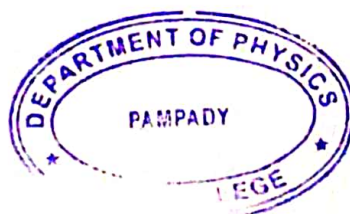

The IQAC of the college shared the consolidated feedback collected from parents and students for the year 2020-21. Given below are the measures taken to address the concerns.

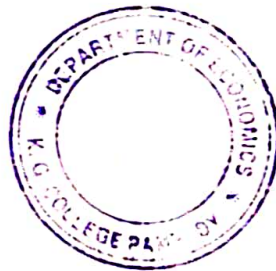
| # | Feedback  | Action Taken   |

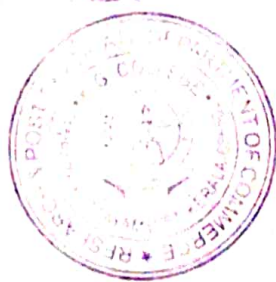

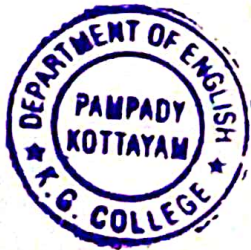
