




REPORT OF STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY 2018-19



1. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process through feedback and similar system.






2. The institution provides value-added courses imparting transferable and life skills





3. Syllabus covered in the class.

5. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit, study tours, training programs etc and other opportunities for students






6. The institute has an effective mentoring system




7. The overall quality of teaching-learning process is very good.



8. The institute provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. (like sports, training programs, NSS, NCC, etc.)


9. The institution has well-furnished support facilities-laboratory, library, sports complex, computer classrooms etc.






10. Students are benefited by guidance for competitive examinations and career counselling offered by the institution


11. Efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.






12. The institution has student council and representation of students on academic and administrative bodies/committees of the institution


13. Welfare schemes for students like scholarships, fellowships, etc are available.

ANALYSIS

Student satisfaction surveys invite constructive suggestions from the students to identify the areas of improvement.

The results of a student satisfaction survey conducted during the 2018-19 academic year were examined using a 5-point scale. An offline survey yielded 118 responses.15 parameters related to the quality of teaching-learning process and facilities of the college are measured. 82% of students chose "Strongly Agree" and "Agree" to indicate that overall teaching quality is very high or exceptional. 8 students requested for the implementation of student-centered and activity-based learning. Some students urged that tests be held at the appropriate times. Around 11 students wanted increased computer availability and other infrastructure facilities. Several students proposed that the university make more efforts to involve students in the monitoring, review, and continuous quality improvement of the teaching-learning process. Although most students are found to be pleased with the present promotion of internship, study tour, field trip, and training programmes, a few are not. A portion of students said that the college should provide sufficient guidance for competitive examinations and career advising.

ACTION TAKEN

The IQAC advised that initiatives such as internships, field trips, improved computer access, and other infrastructure facilities be considered. It was also determined to inform the relevant authorities about the need of conducting examinations on time. Implementation of activities involving students in monitoring and reviewing the teaching-learning process is also taken into account.
