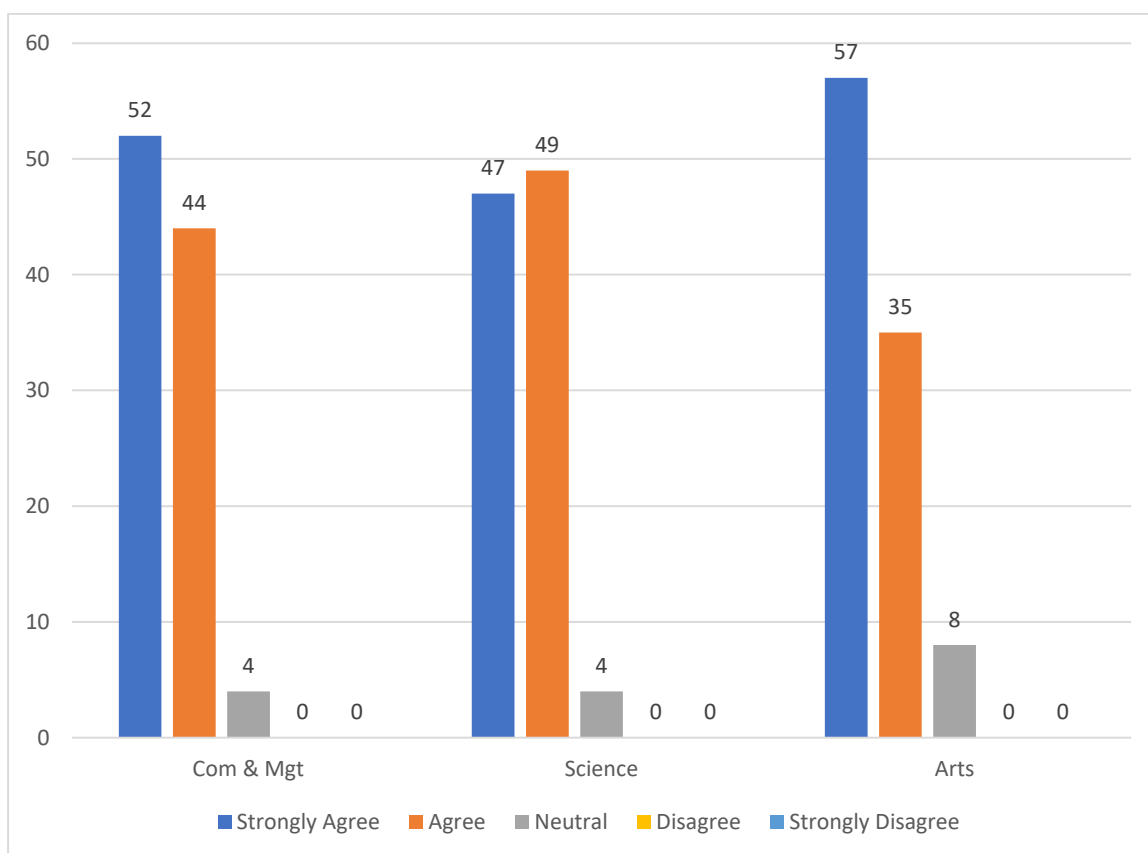

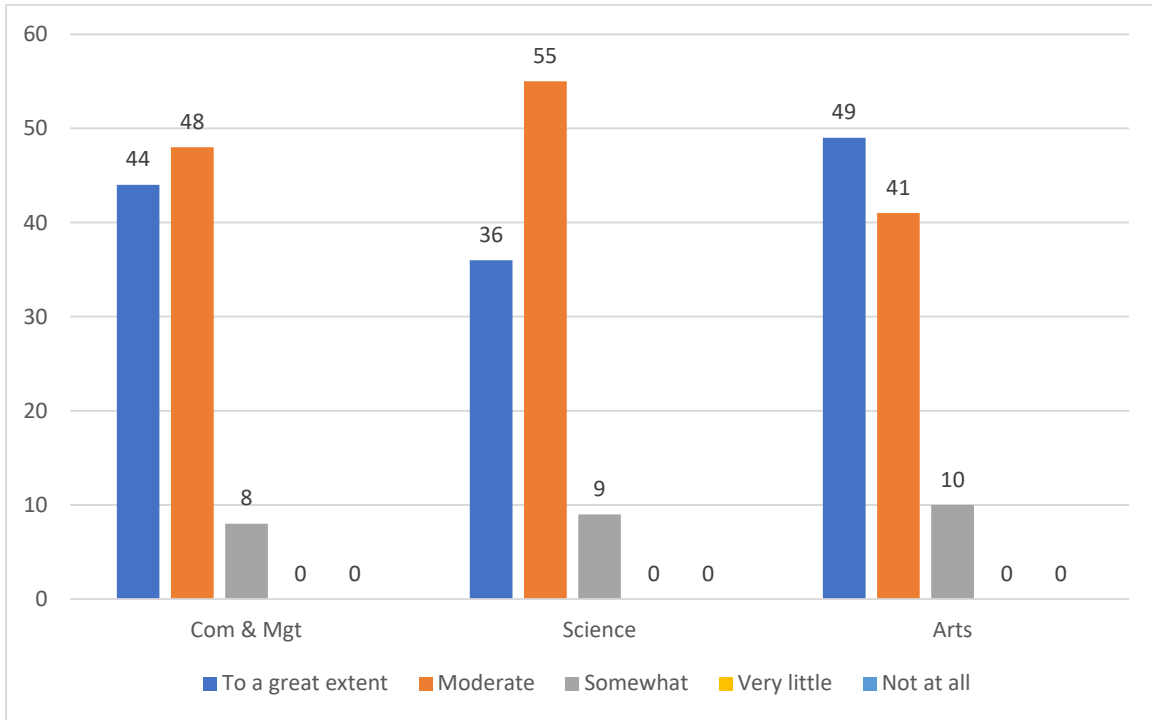
REPORT OF STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY 2019-2020

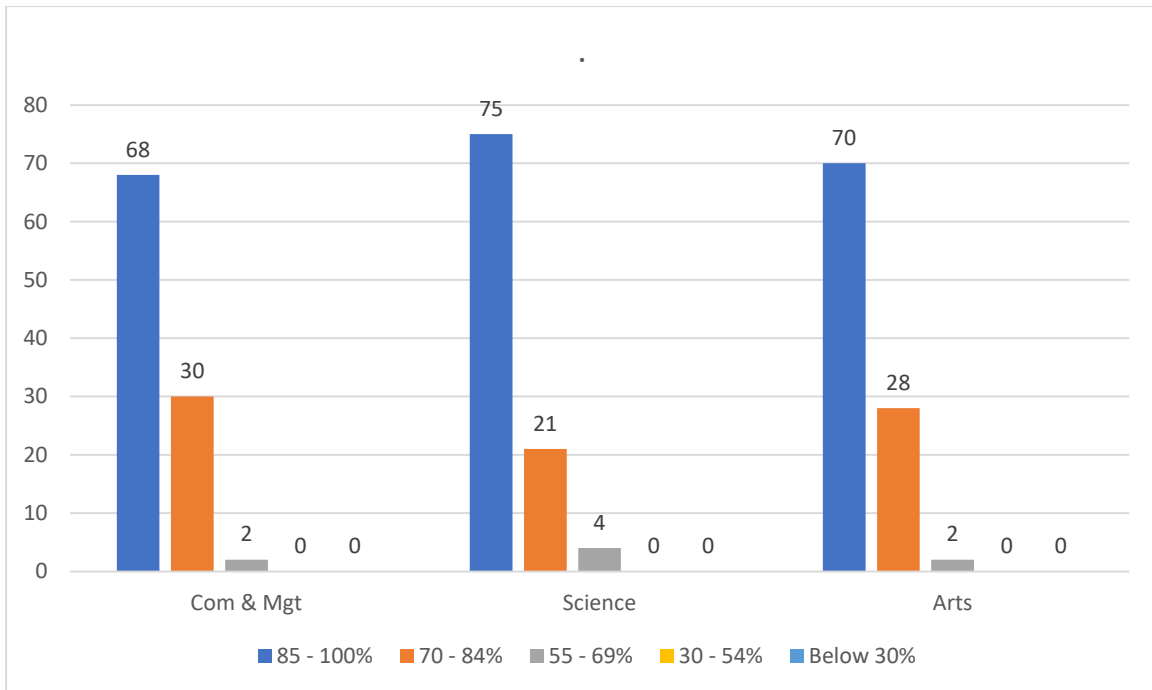
- 1. The institute makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching-learning process through feedback and similar systems**



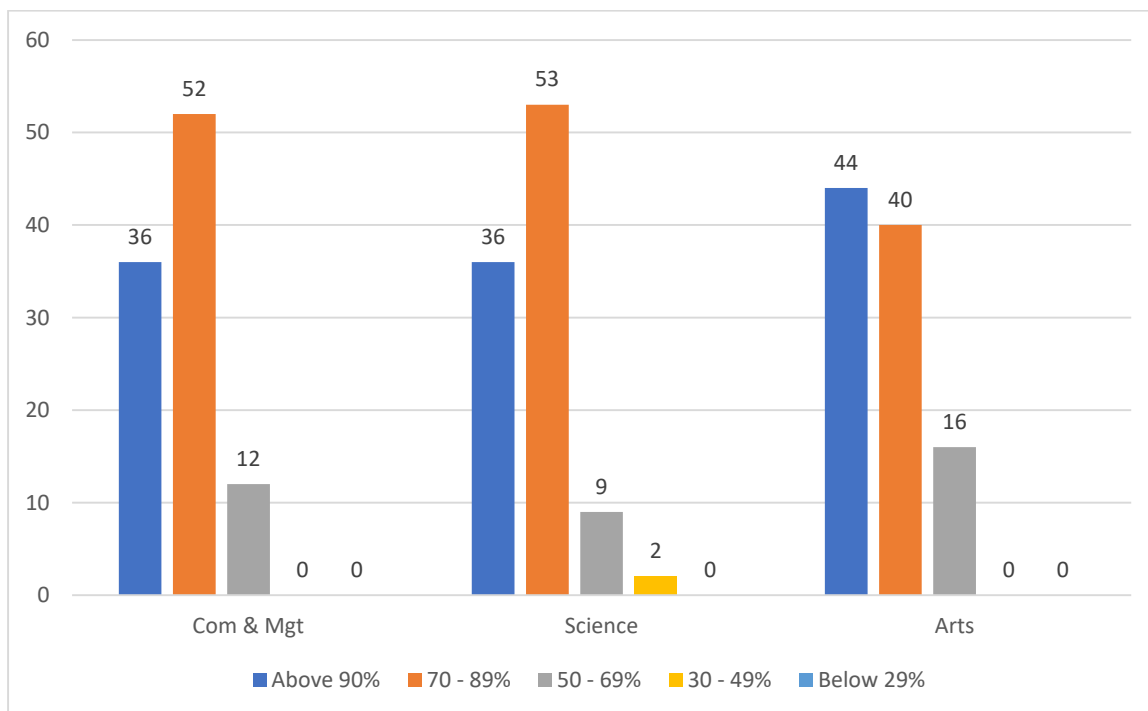
2. The institute provides value-added courses imparting transferable and life skills



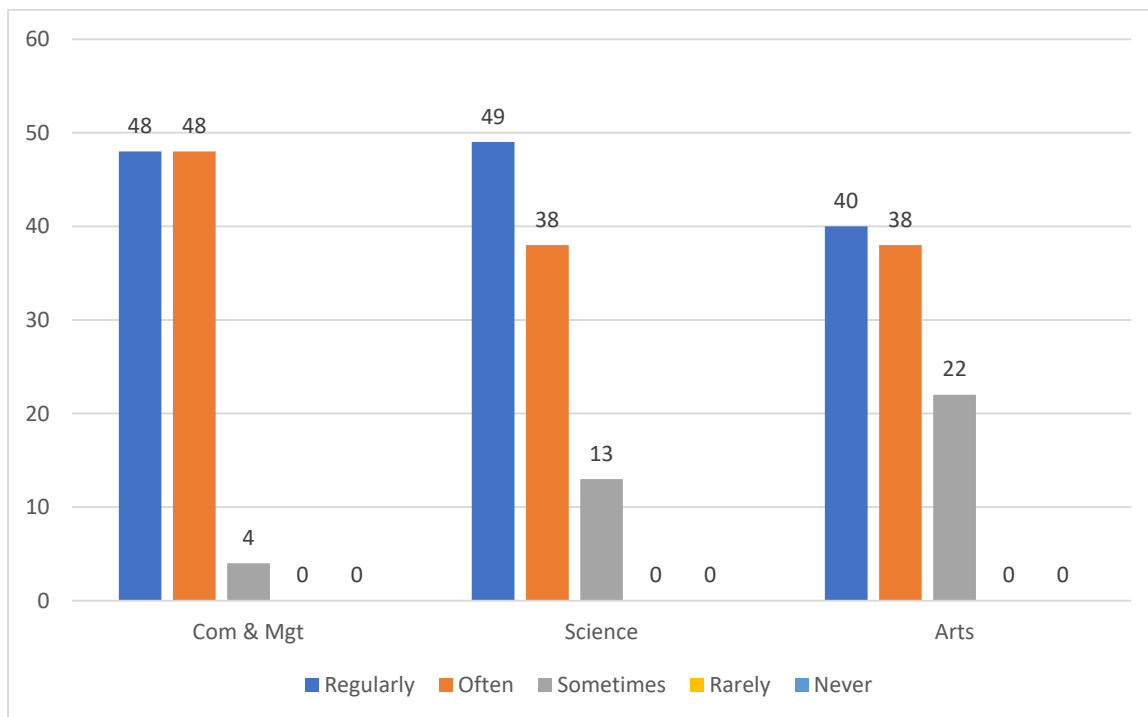

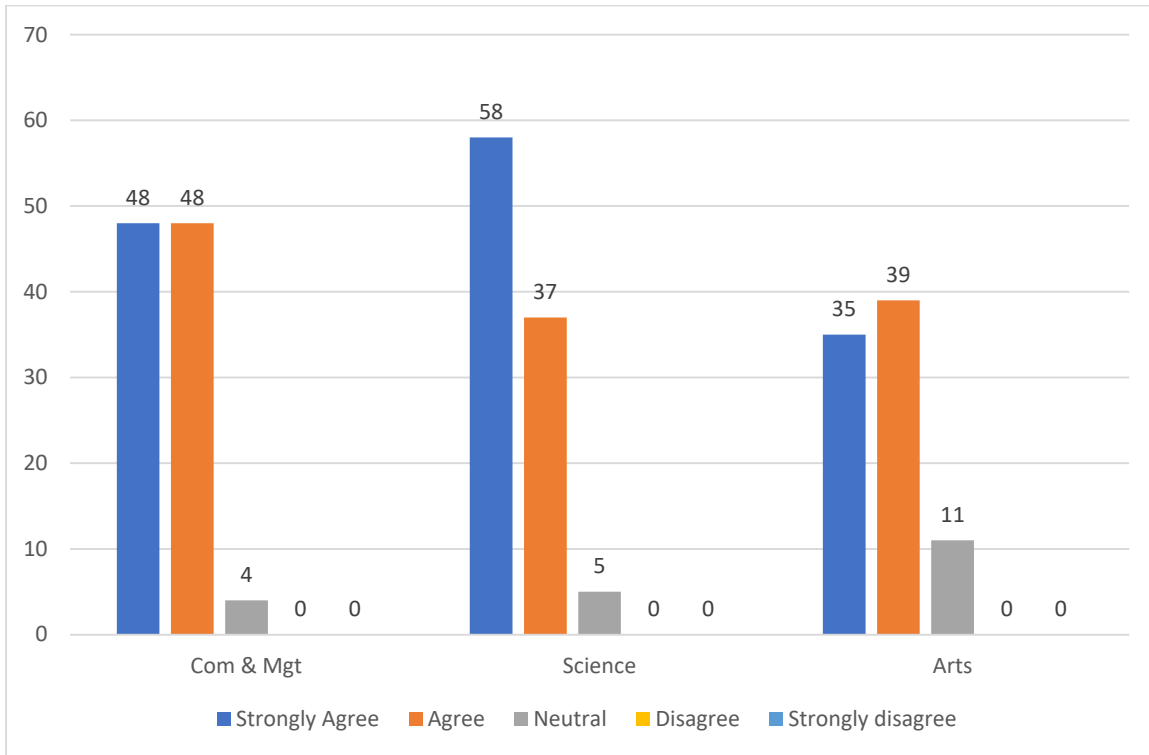
4. Percentage of teachers using ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia, etc. while teaching



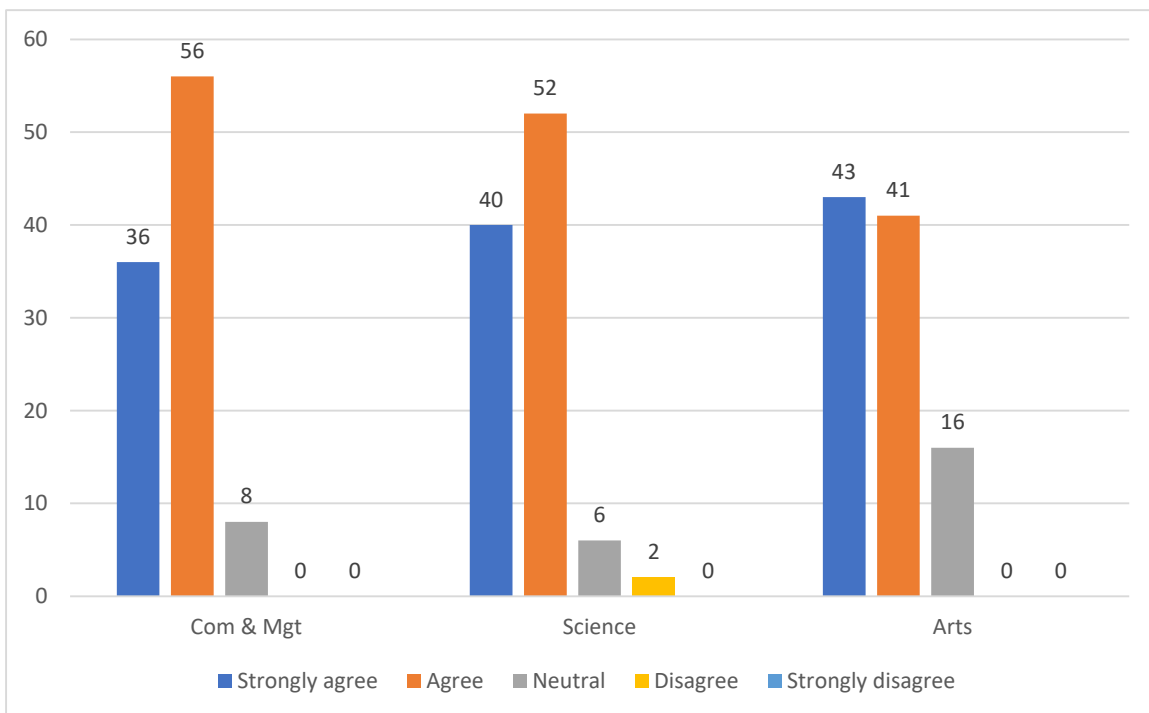
5. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit, study tours, training programs etc and other opportunities for students



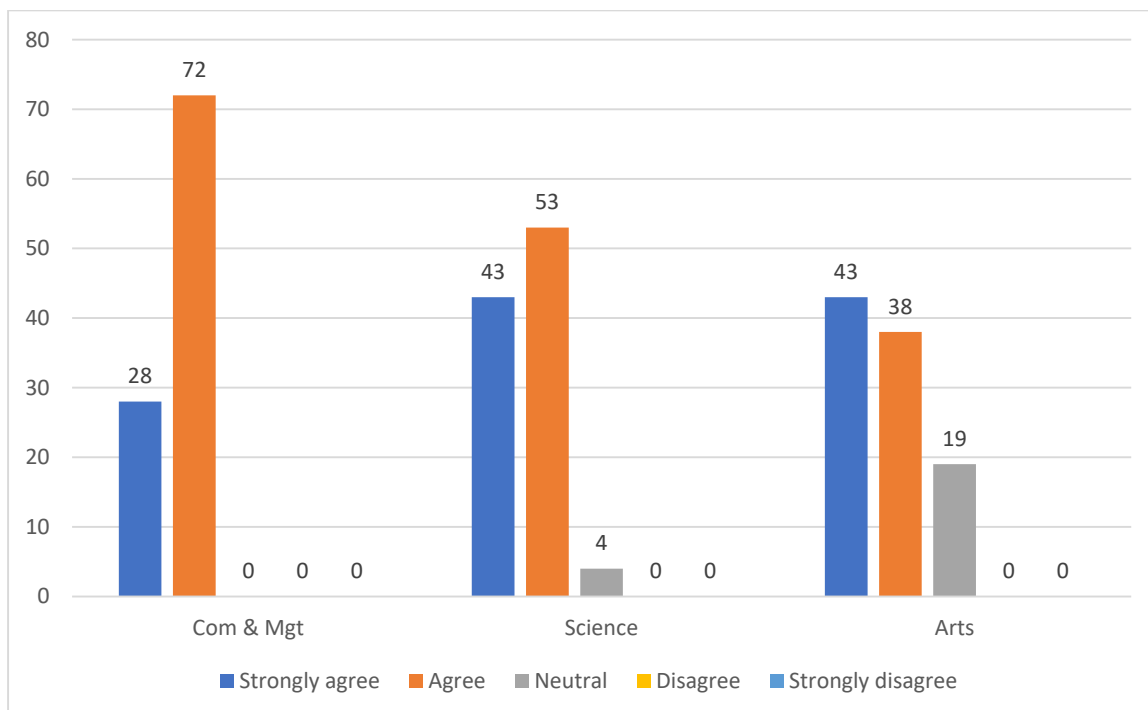
6. The institute has an effective mentoring system



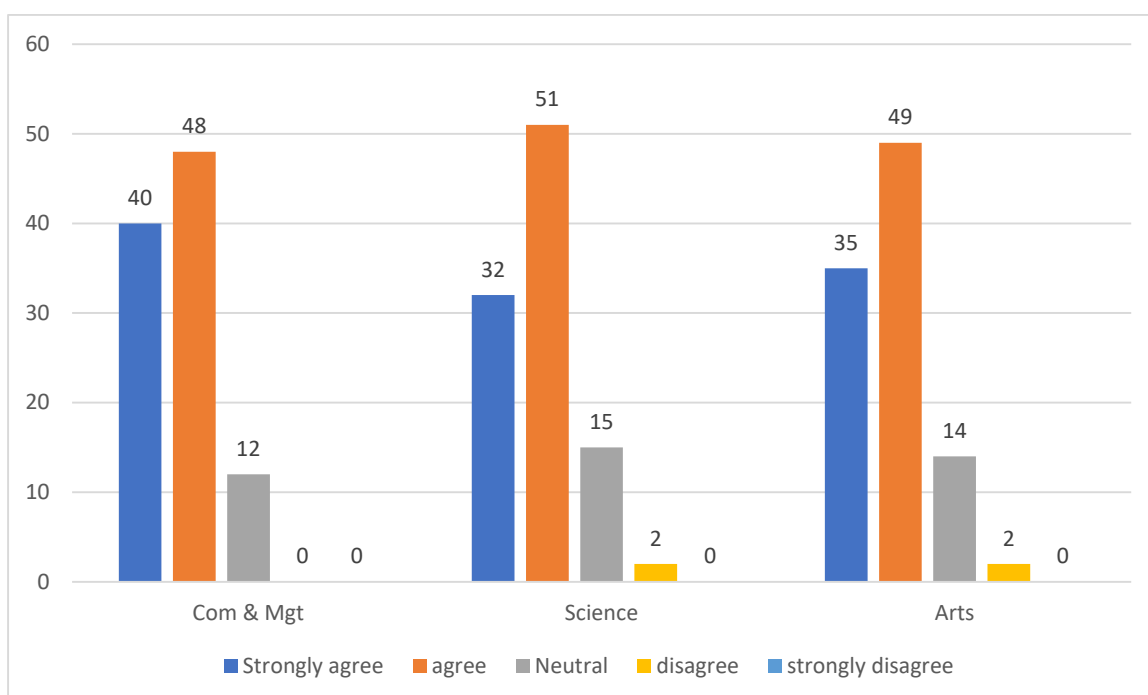
7. The overall quality of teaching learning process is very good



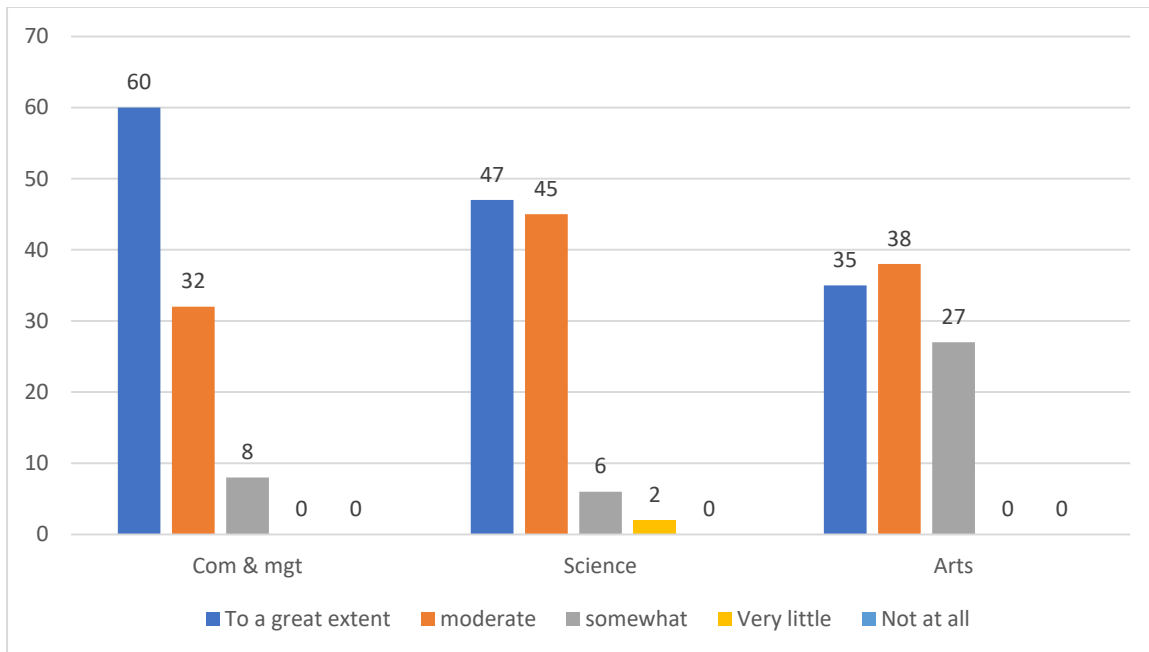
8. The institute provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow



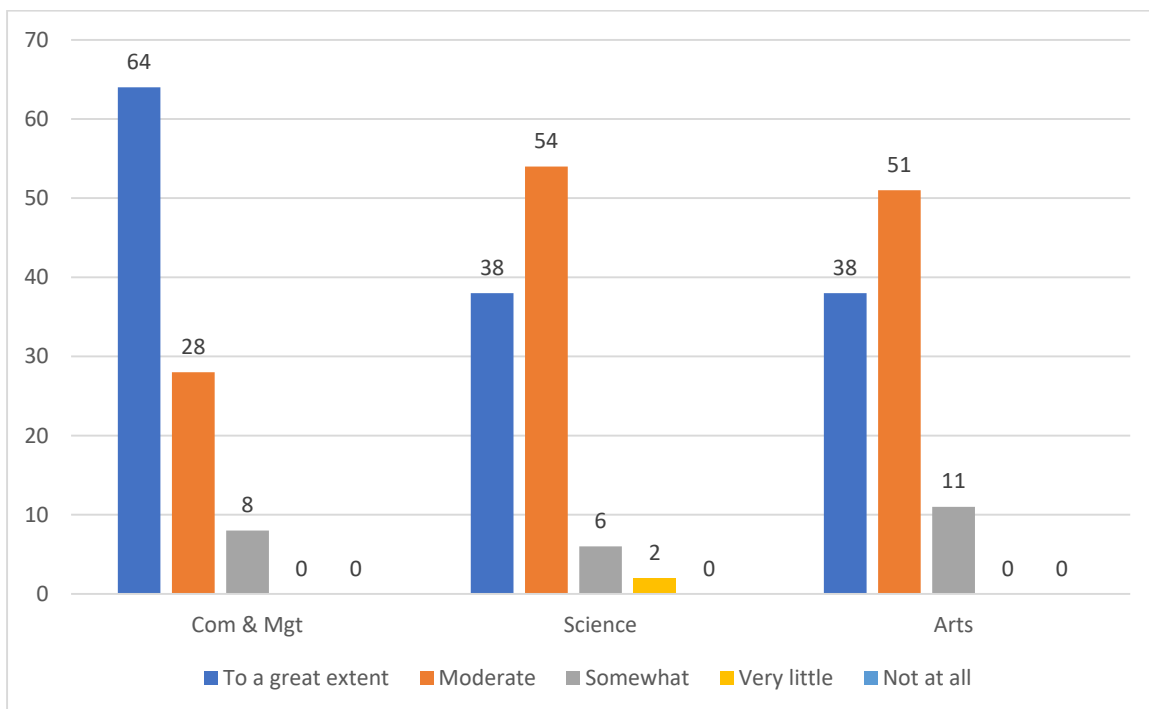
9. The institute has well-furnished support facilities.



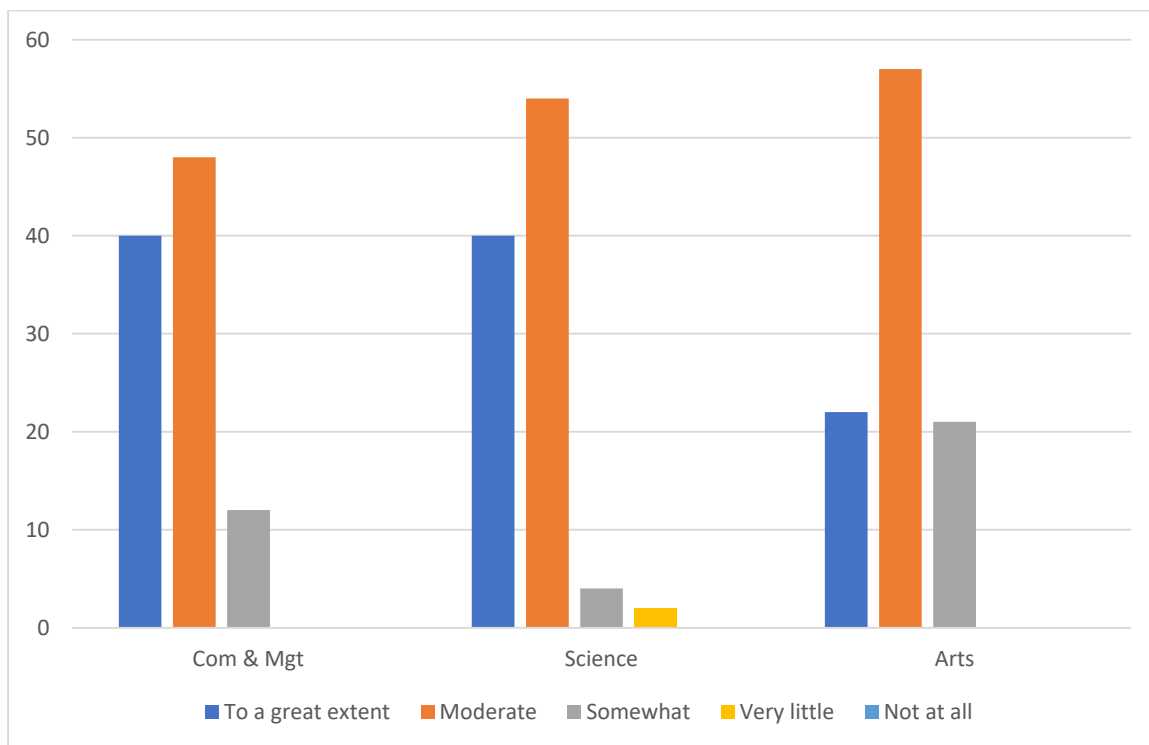
10. Students are benefited by guidance for competitive examinations and career counseling offered by the institute



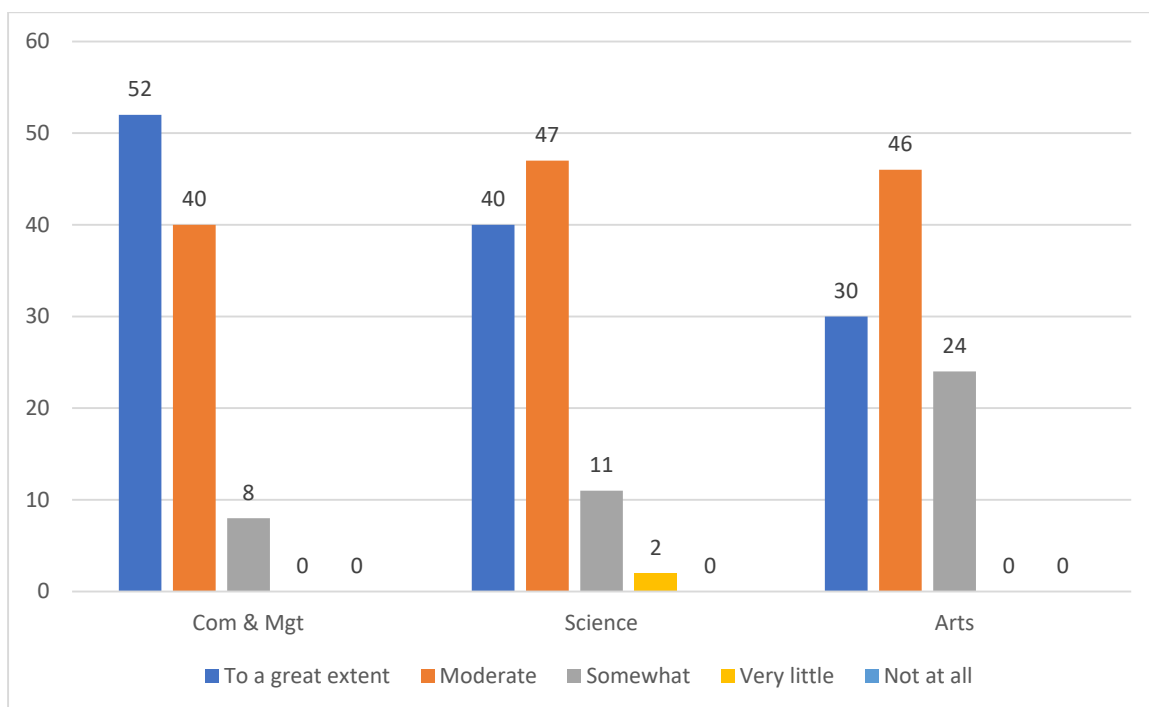
11. Efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work



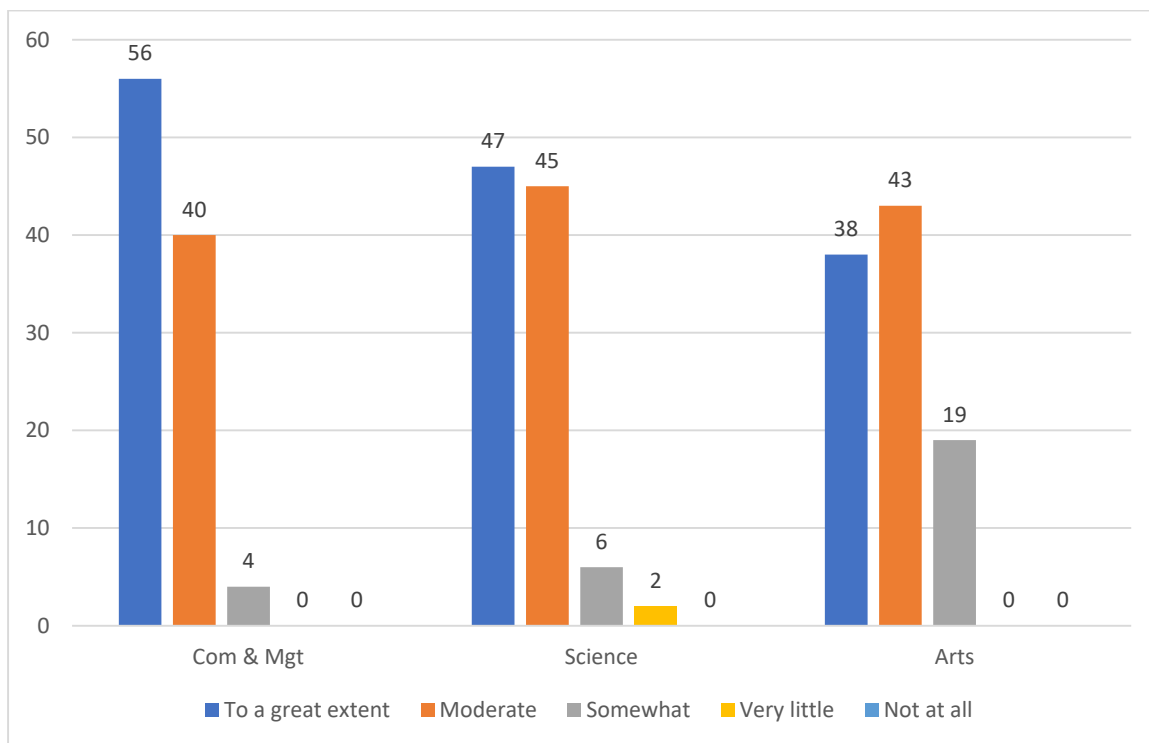
12. The institute has student council and representation of students in academic and administrative bodies/committees of the institution



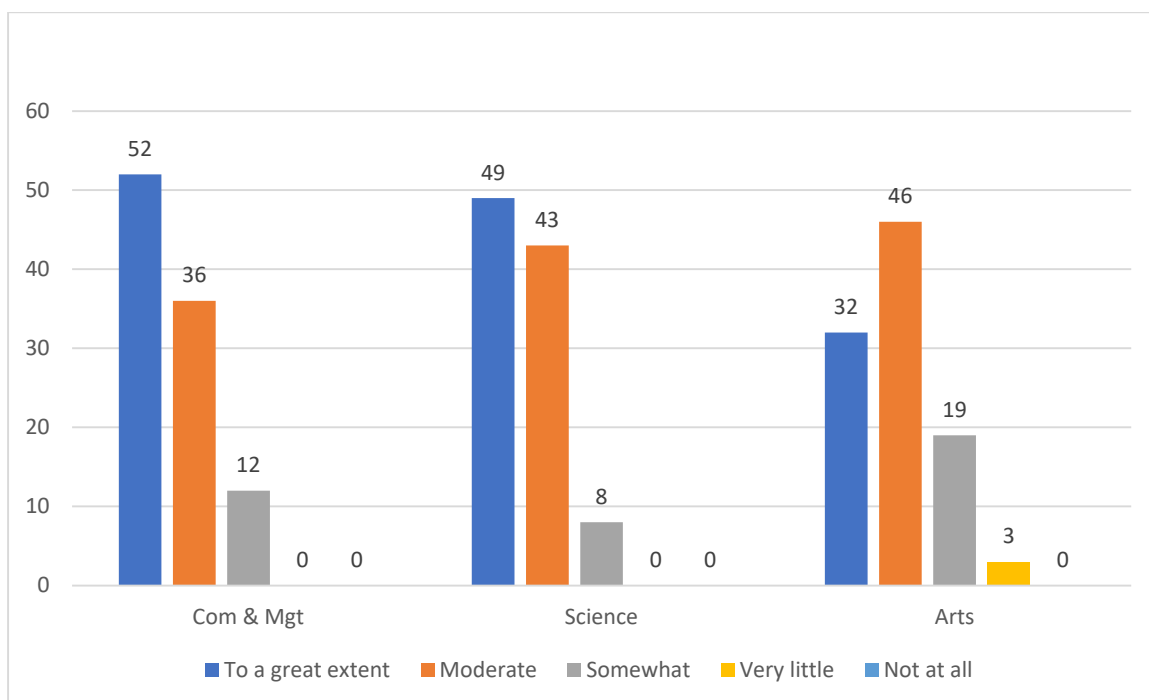
13. Welfare schemes for students like scholarships, fellowships, etc are available.

ANALYSIS

The quality of the teaching learning process, methods, structures and facilities provided by the college are periodically rated by conducting student satisfaction survey. This provides the institution a chance to identify the areas that need improvement.

The result of the student satisfaction survey conducted during the academic year 2019-20 was analysed based on a five-point scale. An offline survey received 109 responses. 15 parameters to rate the competency of the teachers, quality of the teaching-learning process and infrastructure of the institution were considered. The survey rates the overall teaching quality as the best and of high standards. 89% of students chose “Strongly Agree” and “Agree” in rating the overall teaching quality.

The students suggested improvement in the efforts to inculcate soft skills, life skills, and employability skills provided by the institution. Also, students expect more value-added courses to improve their employability skills.

ACTION TAKEN

The IQAC proposed to design and include add-on courses useful for the students to function and prepare for their careers. Workshops on soft skills and life skills were conducted in the college for the students.
