





1. Syllabus covered in the class






2. Teachers made good preparation for the class




3. Teachers possess good communication skills






4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers






6. The performance in assignments was discussed with you




7. The institution takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange and field visit opportunities






8. Teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and economic growth




9. Institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow






10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes




11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you






12. The teacher illustrates the concepts through examples and applications




13. The teachers identify your strength and encourage you with providing right level of challenges






14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them




15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process






16. The institute/teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences




17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities






18. Efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work




19. Percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia, etc. while teaching

ANALYSIS

Feedback surveys are a valuable tool to advance student interest and instill productive changes in the institution.

The result of a student satisfaction survey conducted during the year 2022-2023 academic year was examined using a 5-point scale. An offline survey yielded 99 responses. 20 parameters on the various elements of the teaching-learning process and the facilities provided by the institution are measured in the survey. The result of the survey proves that the teachers of the institution maintain high standards in teaching. 79% of students choose "Strongly Agree" and "Agree" to indicate that the teacher quality is very high or exceptional.

The survey indicates the improvement needed in current opportunities for internships, field visits, and student exchange programmes. The survey also demands an increased use of ICT tools by the teachers in the classrooms.

ACTIONS TAKEN

The IQAC recommended, considering the constructive suggestions generated from the survey to include ICT tools into the teaching learning process and to take initiatives to provide best internship and field visit opportunities for the students.
