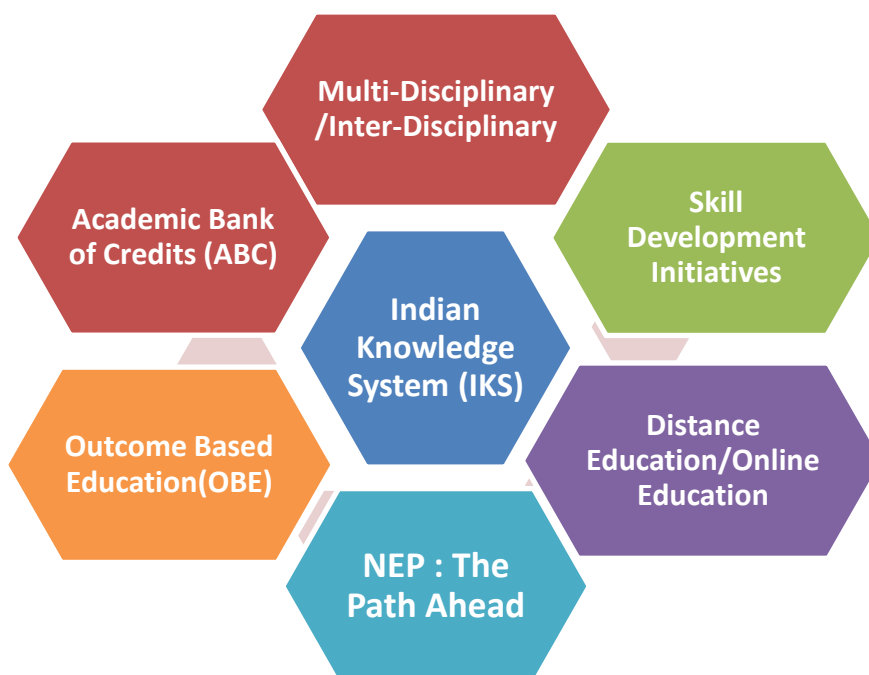
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INTRODUCTION

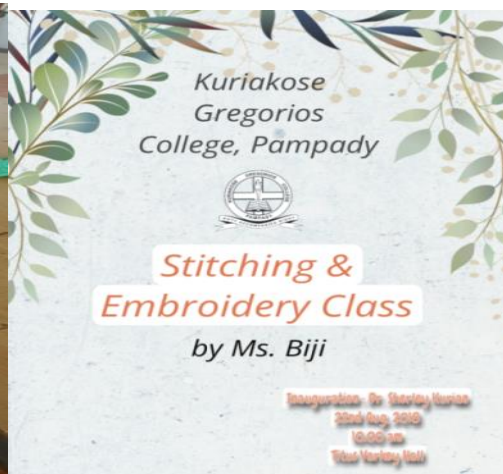






SKILL DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES

DISTANCE EDUCATION/ONLINE EDUCATION

KG College has always been open and flexible in encouraging the teachers to adopt **ICT in classroom teaching** and **modern pedagogical techniques** for enhancing the teaching-learning experience. During the pandemic, **distance education** and **internet education** were common modalities of instruction. Digital platforms including **Google Classroom, Zoom, Google Meet,** and **Webex** were used to handle all academic transactions, including *class, test papers, assignments, and seminar submissions*.
