ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2020-21

#	Feedback	Action Taken
1	Provide freedom to students for exploring the subject rather than limiting them to exam oriented studies.	Students are given library sessions to explore the discipline beyond the limits of syllabus.
2	More attention to the students' skills, arts and sports.	Arts fests and sports meets are annually conducted in the college. Besides several department level fests and interdepartmental as well as inter collegiate competitions are organised. However Covid has dampened the conduct of various programmes that demand student gatherings.
3	Mentor mentee activities should be improved	Faculties at department level are giving personal attention to students especially in the event of Covid.
4	Include extra-curricular activities for students' mental relaxation.	The online classes were putting a stress on students, so the department organised several webinars, training sessions etc for giving mental support.
5	Previous question paper discussion	Teachers are requested to discuss previous year question papers- both internal and external and prepare question banks to be distributed among students group.



6	The subjects have to be presented and evaluated by providing more practical experiments and applications other than just theoretical presentation, memorizing and writing exams.	Project work is submitted by every final year student. Often this provides opportunity for first hand interaction with the society for data collection and survey. Other than project, we have limited scope for practical sessions in economics. However the department is conducting awareness programmes, street-plays etc to introduce the issues in Economics and Political Science.
7	Conduct Examinations on time	It was Covid Pandemic that disrupted the smooth conduct of exams on time. However in future the University will be able to conduct examinations as per schedule.

3	Suggestion for career counseling.	Due to COVID pandemic, students are encouraged to take part in online workshops, lectures, etc. related to the subject.
4	Regarding interactive sessions.	It is suggested to keep at-least one class in 15 days for general discussions with students so as to make online classes lively.
5	Concepts not being clear due to online mode, long hours of screen time where they face health issues as well as decrease in productivity and efficiency.	Reduced the timing of online classes.
