Kuriakose Gregorios College, Pampady is a unique temple of higher education in many respects. From its beginnings in 1981, the college has today, by the infinite grace of God, risen to the status of an academy of name and fame. The College was founded in 1981 as a tribute to the late lamented Kuriakose Mar Gregorios (Pampady Thirumeni), the saintly Metropolitan of the Kottayam Diocese of the Malankara Orthodox Church.

Started as a junior college with a few Pre- Degree batches, the College was upgraded in 1991 to the status of an undergraduate institution, with the sanctioning of B.A. (Economics) programme. B. Sc. (Chemistry) and B.Com programmes got started in 1993 and 1995 respectively, and with the commencement of M.Com. programme in 1998, the College became a postgraduate institution. B. Sc. (Physics) programme was launched in 1999 and B. Sc. (Zoology) in 2001. A new self-financing programme (B.B.A) was sanctioned in the year 2002. M. Sc. (Physics) programme was launched in 2004 in the self- financing stream. Another significant development was the elevation of the Commerce department to the status of a research center in 2009 by the MG University. The third P.G. Programme M. Sc. Zoology(Fisheries) with an intake of 12 students commenced from the academic year 2013-14 in the aided stream. In 2015- 16 BA English Language & Literature was started in the self-financing stream. In the year 2021, B. Sc. Food Science and Quality Control (aided) commenced as the eighth UG programme of the College. Along with these UG / PG programmes, students are also provided with the opportunities to undertake several add-on courses on different streams run by various departments and certificate courses collaborated with reputed institutes.

All the UG/PG Departments have earned academic repute at par with any premier institutions in the university through their impressive organization of Intercollegiate Programmes, Seminars, Workshops and National/ International Conferences, extension and outreach activities.

KG College could continue to gather academic laurels with 100% pass/top grades in BA/BSc/BCom/BBA/MCom/MScProgrammes and several university top positions. The UGC sponsored St. Eulethee's Women's Hostel is functional and has an intake capacity of 50 students since 2010. Residential facilities for Male Students are also provided separately. The college has state-of-the art facilities in its Administrative Block as well as the updated technology assisted gadgets to provide top-class teaching/ learning processes. The campus also houses all mandatory requirements of a modern college including a well- stocked automated Library, Computer Centre and well-equipped Laboratory facilities, Student Amenities Centers for both Men & Women, Fitness Centre, Cafeteria, adequate facilities for Sports & Games, A.C. Seminar Halls, Smart Lecture Hall and an Auditorium.

We also have a career guidance and Placement Division which provides career

counselling and guidance to the students in pursuing job opportunities. Various statutory bodies like Anti-Ragging cell and squad, Student Grievances Redressal Cell, Internal Complaint Committee are constituted for timely resolution of complaints regarding ragging and grievances of students and functions effectively. The vibrant units of NSS, NCC, MGOCSM and various Clubs of the college offer excellent exposure for ambitious youth to take up co-curricular and extra-curricular initiatives. - UG and PG admissions are being conducted under CAP system (Common Admission Procedure). Details can be downloaded from <u>http://cap.mgu.ac.in</u> (<u>Mahatma Gandhi University UG CAP</u> & <u>Mahatma</u> <u>Gandhi University PG CAP</u>) Website (Admissions).
- □ Index Marks/ Bonus Marks for admission will be calculated as per University rules.
- At the time of interview, the candidates shall produce the following documents in original:
 - i. Qualifying Certificates/ Mark lists (SSLC Book, Plus Two or Equivalent Mark List, BA/BSc/BCom Mark Lists/ Degree).
 - ii. Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
 - iii. Latest Income Certificate (taken within one year) and Caste Certificate (taken within three years) from Village Officer (for fee concession)
 - iv. Income Certificate and Caste/ Community Certificates in the case of SC/ST/OBC/OEC applicants.
 - v. Provisional Degree Certificates
 - vi. Three Passport size Photographs
 - vii. Eligibility/ Recognition Certificate & Migration Certificate, if applicable.
 - viii. All other relevant certificates claimed for index mark calculation (eg. N.C.C., N.S.S., Dependents of Ex- Servicemen etc.)
- □ Students selected for admission shall pay fees immediately as per University/Govt. deadline.
- □ Candidates who seek admission under the Management Quota should get the Sponsorship form from the College Office.
- Admission to aided courses is governed by the terms of agreement between the Management of the College and Government.
 - 50% seats will be filled by open selection on the basis of merit.
 - 10% seats will be reserved for the students belonging to the orthodox Community.
 - 20% seats will be reserved for students belonging to Scheduled Castes/Tribes.
 - 20% seats will be filled by students from management quota.
- Anyone who secures admission to the College on the basis of false or erroneous information will forfeit his/her seat as soon as the matter comes to the notice of the authorities. If the documents are not produced at the

time of interview admission will not be given.

- □ The principal reserves the right to refuse admission to any applicant without assigning any reason.
- □ Political activism is strictly banned on the campus. All students are required to abide by the rules and regulations.
- □ Students involved in ragging cases either in College or Hostel will be expelled from the College &/or Hostel at any time during the course of study. Any case of ragging will be immediately reported to the police. The direction from the honorable Supreme Court, the UGC & the Government will be strictly followed.
