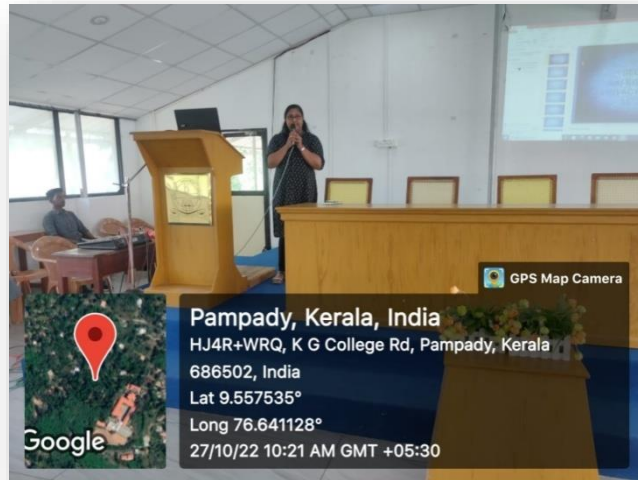
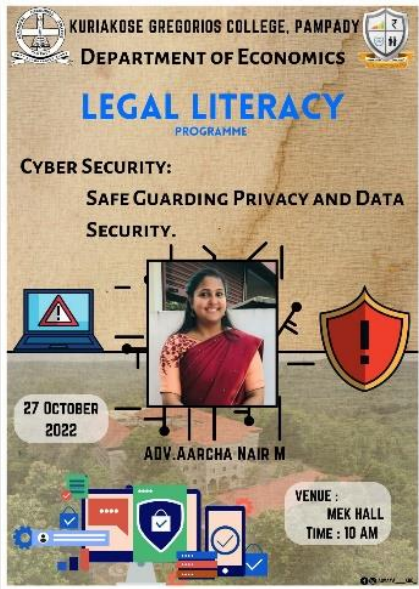
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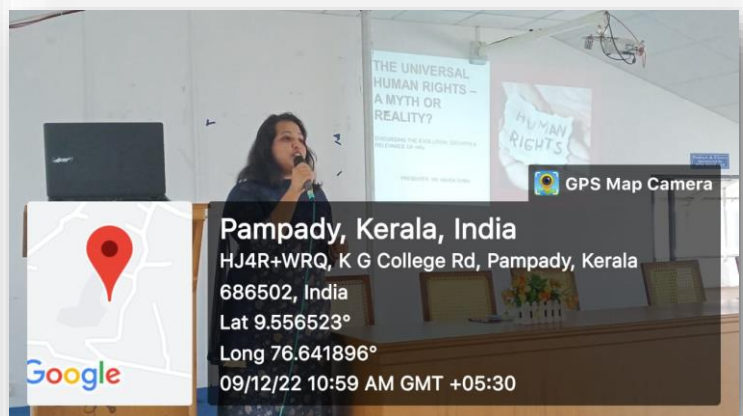
Seminar On Cyber Security: Safeguarding Privacy & Data Security

On November 1, 2022, 20 cadets from KG College assisted in traffic management during a district procession, responding to a request from civil administration due to a shortage of traffic personnel.



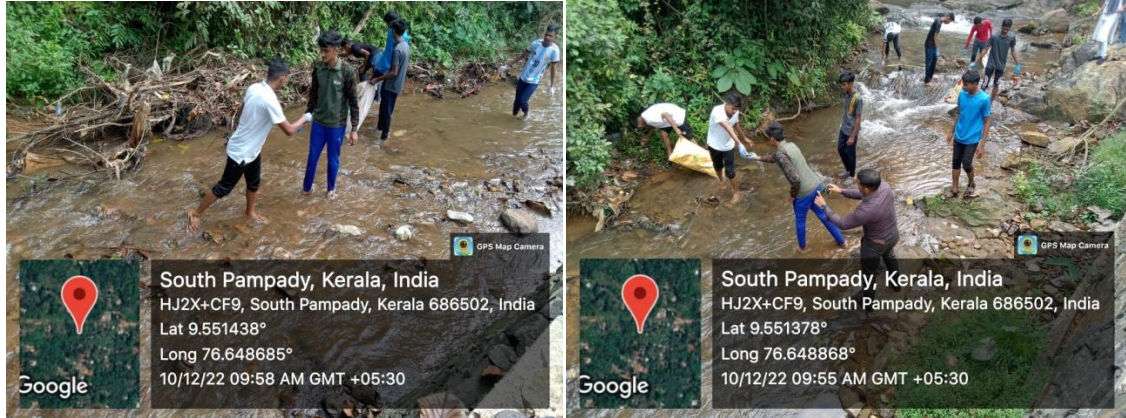
Self Defence Training

Clean India Drive

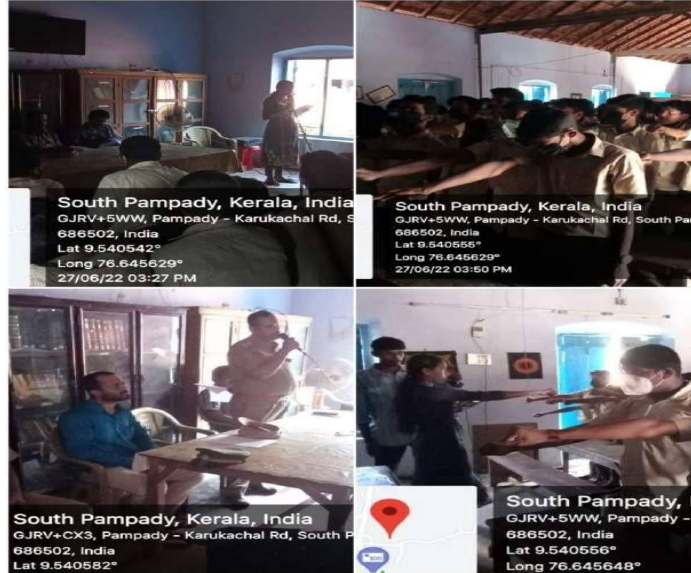

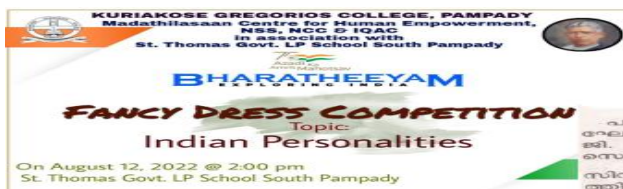

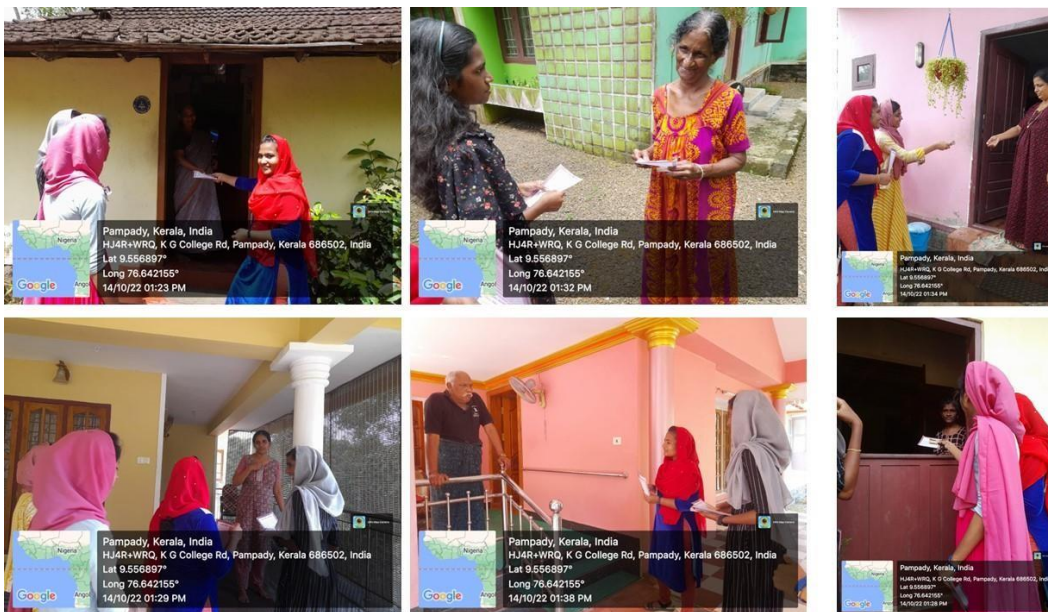
Pesticide Awareness Programme

The Department of Economics distributed vegetable saplings in Ward 12, Pampady, on 10 May 10, 2022 to encourage organic farming practices.



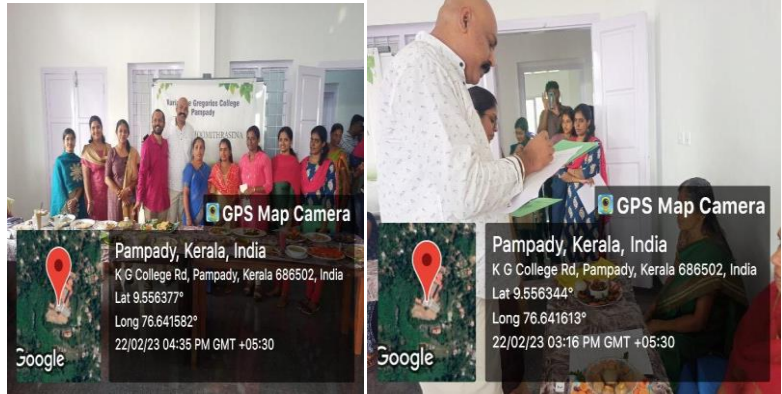
Distribution of Study Materials
