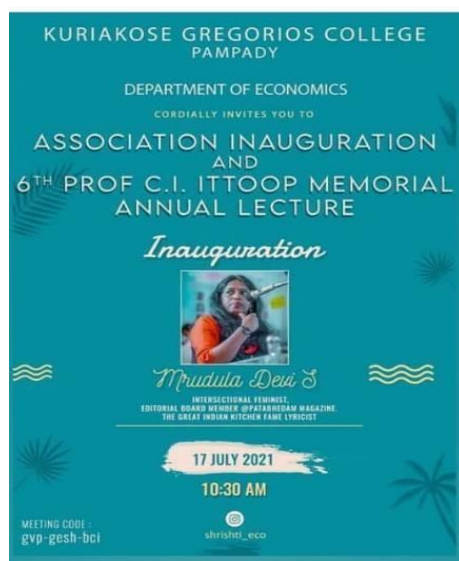
### Webinar on structure – property relation in materials

### Seminar on emerging trends and recent advances in biological research

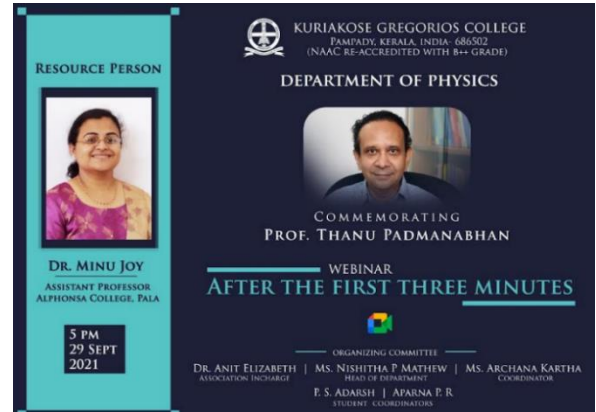

Kumar (scientist, Kerala state remote sensing and environment centre, Thiruvananthapuram) elaborated on this topic.



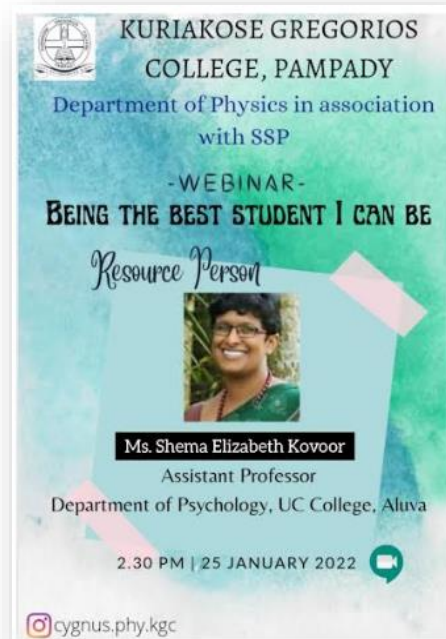
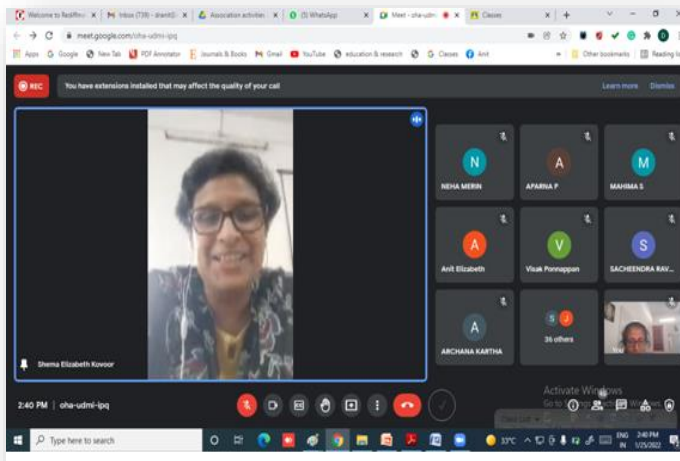
### Webinar on after the first three minutes

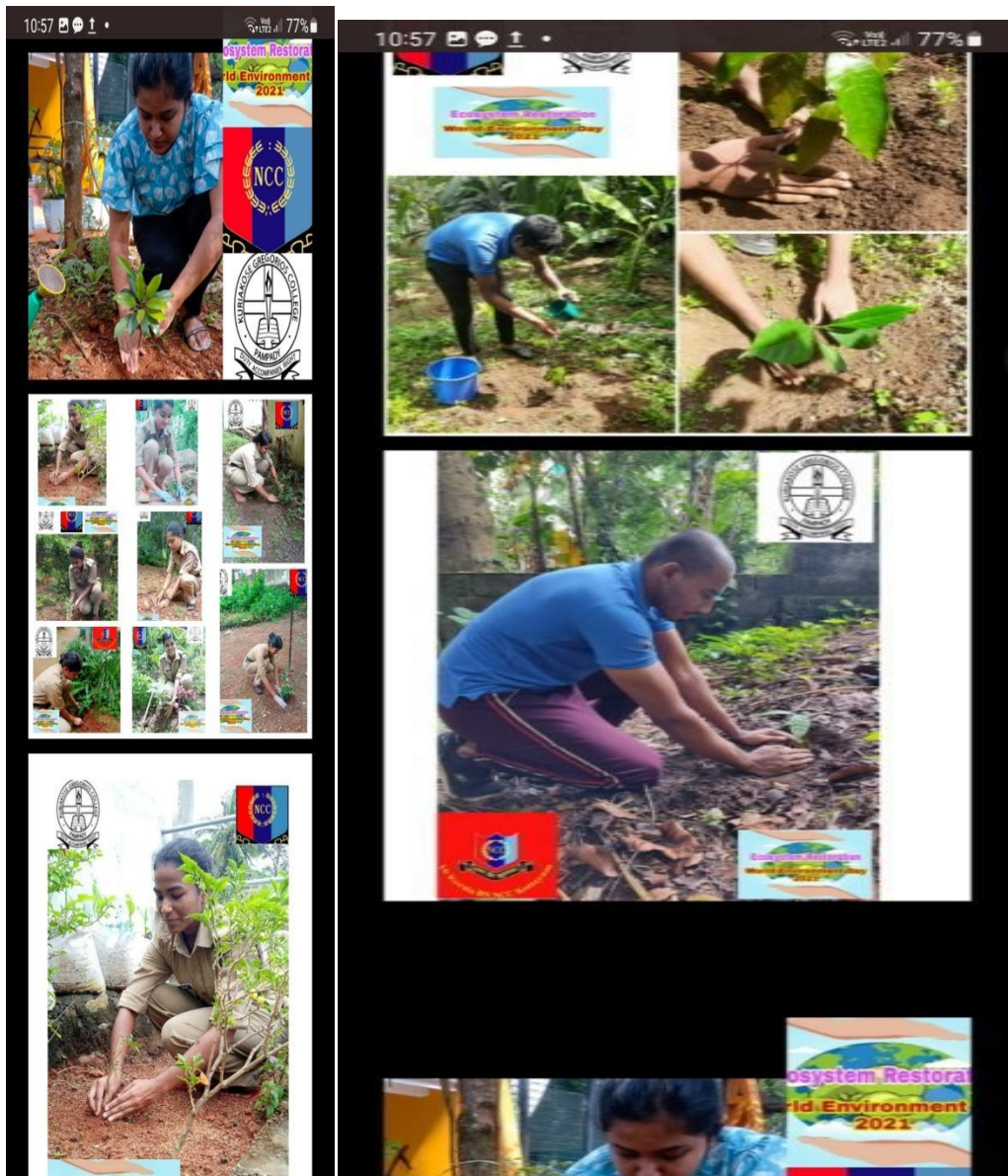

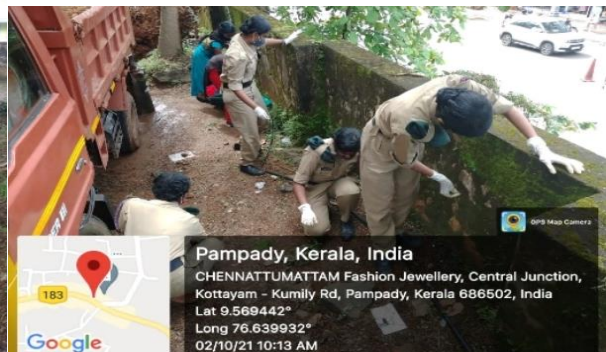
### Mumbai attack remembrance and reception to AKSA bike rally

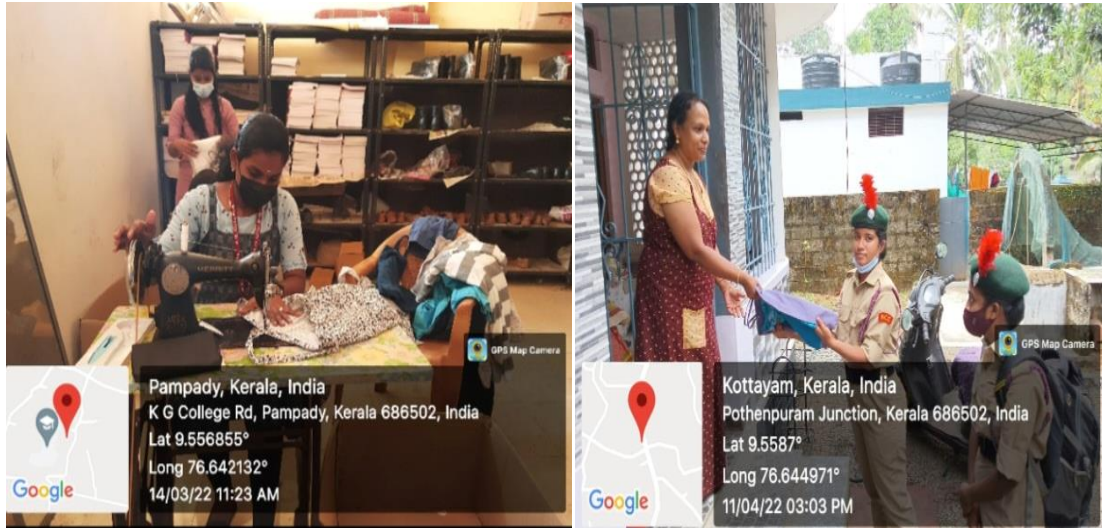
**Swachhata Pakhwada**

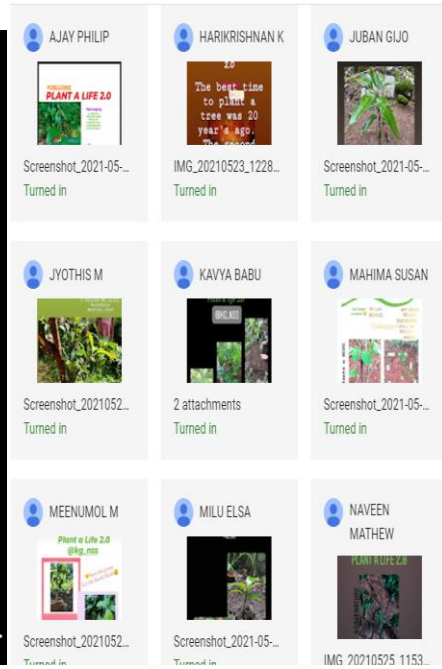
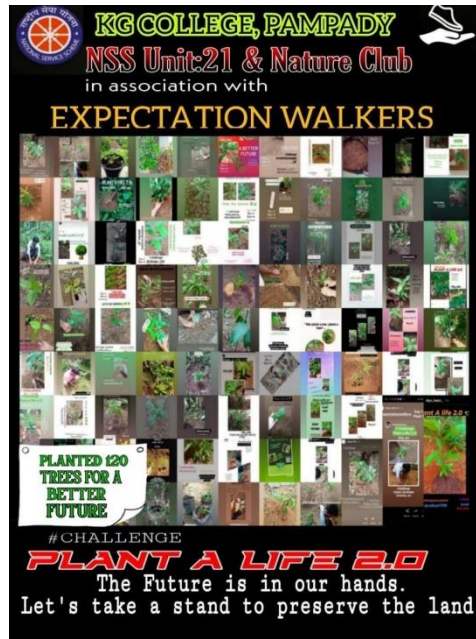
### Making and distribution of cloth bags
