

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



Gregorian Lecture on Nano Technology: Fundamentals and Applications






Webinar on Termite Diversity in Kerala









Lecture on Introduction To Yoga

The Department of Economics celebrated World Tourism Day by conducting an interactive session with Mr. Krishna Kumar P.C, a traveller and magician who travelled all over India.








Lecture on Legal Provisions in Civil-Criminal Litigation








Lecture on Importance of Toponomy in Local History


Jalianwalla bagh Massacre Remembrance and Plogging

Food packets were distributed to poor people in the streets of Kottayam as part of World Food Day.










Hair Donation to Cancer Patients






Plant a Volunteer, Plant a Tree

The NSS Volunteers enthusiastically joined the Sanadhasena to help the police officers and health officials to fight against COVID 19.




COVID-19 & Childcare
